## BBNC Education Foundation HE/VE Scholarship Program Guidelines and Application

To be considered for the HE/VE scholarship program, complete the enclosed application and all required attachments and submit to the BBNC Education Foundation, 111 W. 16<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Suite 400, Anchorage, AK 99501; or fax to 1-907-265-7886; or email to [bbncef@bbnc.net](mailto:bbncef@bbnc.net).

Please remember to make arrangements to have your official transcripts sent to the BBNC Education Foundation prior to the deadline date via by mail, in person or electronically. Electronic transcripts must be sent to the Education Foundation email address at [bbncef@bbnc.net](mailto:bbncef@bbnc.net) **via a secure transcript exchange company or as a certified PDF document.**

The scholarship program is competitive and limited by budget, therefore, some eligible applicants may not be awarded a scholarship and there is no guarantee of funding. The eligibility requirements for the BBNCEF scholarship awards follow:

Applications must be complete and received (not postmarked) by the BBNC Education Foundation by **5 p.m. AK time on April 6, 2018.**

### First-time applicants!

If you **DID NOT** receive an HE/VE scholarship award from the BBNCEF for the 2017-18 school year, you must complete the application and attach ALL of the following information to the completed application:

- Essay
- Proof of Application or Acceptance to the school you plan to attend
- Most Recent OFFICIAL High School or College Transcripts (*Transcripts must be in an envelope sealed by your school's Registrar or Records Office in order to be an "official copy."*)  
**\*Electronic versions of transcripts are now accepted, certified PDF transcripts must be delivered from a verified/secured source .**
- Two letters of recommendation (one personal and one professional). Do not include recommendations from immediate family members. Letters must be dated within one year.
- Resume (limit to one page)
- Digital photo

### Returning Applicants!

If you received a scholarship award from the BBNCEF for the 2017-18 school year, please complete the application and attach ONLY the following information:

- Essay
- Proof of Application or Acceptance to the school you plan to attend (*If it is **NOT** the same school you attended in 2017-18.*)
- Most Recent OFFICIAL Transcripts (*Transcripts must be in an envelope sealed by your school's Registrar or Records Office in order to be an "official copy."*)  
**\*Electronic versions of transcripts are now accepted, certified PDF transcripts must be delivered from a verified/secured source .**

### New this academic year! Electronic transcripts are now accepted. Tips for submitting your official transcripts:

Official and unopened transcripts are required for the HE/VE scholarship program in order to verify enrollment, class standing and cumulative GPA. An applicant's most recent official transcripts must be received by the application deadline date of April 6, 2018 in order for an application to be considered complete. *Electronic versions of transcripts are accepted only if submitted to the BBNCEF email address at [bbncef@bbnc.net](mailto:bbncef@bbnc.net), and meet the following conditions:*

- The certified PDF transcript was delivered from a verified/secured source (i.e. Credentials Inc., National Student Clearinghouse, JST)
- The PDF transcript was encrypted/digitally certified
- The issuing institution has marked the transcript as "official"
- A secure email method was used for transcripts that were pushed from the sending institution (or their third-party provider), and the document has NOT already been opened/accessed

Documents are not be accepted as official if the document is not encrypted; is delivered direct or forwarded from students via email; and/or the document has been opened or accessed first by another party.

Prior to disbursement of the second half of an HE/VE award, the most recent official transcripts must be received by the BBNCEF to confirm eligibility requirements.

## BBNCEF General Scholarships – HE/VE Program

### Higher Education Scholarships (4-yr or advanced degree programs; Full time or Part time Enrollment)

Awards based on academic standing, leadership, financial need, and life experiences. Advanced degree programs included. Scholarships are awarded for the academic year.

*ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:*

- Must be a BBNC shareholder
- High school diploma or equivalent (GED)
- Enrolled in an accredited college or university as a full time student, OR part-time student enrolled in at least six credit hours
- Cumulative 2.0 grade point average or better
- Able to show financial need

### Vocational Education Scholarships (2-yr degree or training programs; Full time or Part time Enrollment)

Program established to encourage further educational or career advancement. Vocational education scholarships are awarded for the academic year.

*ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:*

- Must be a BBNC shareholder
- High school diploma or equivalent (GED)
- Enrolled in an accredited vocational institution, college or university as a full time student, OR part-time student enrolled in at least six credit hours
- Cumulative 2.0 grade point average or better
- Able to show financial need

## Named, Partner/Donor and Match Scholarship Programs

These scholarships are dependent upon funding and may or may not be available on an annual basis.

### H. Noble Dick Scholarship

Established by BBNC in memory of the late H. Noble Dick, BBNC president from 1980-1987, who served as the first controller in 1973, then became the vice president and finally CEO of the corporation. He received his BBA in accounting from the University of Alaska Fairbanks and his MBA in finance from Wharton School, University of Pennsylvania. Prior to working with BBNC, Mr. Noble Dick was involved in ANCSA activities including financial analysis of the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act.

*ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:*

- Must be a BBNC shareholder
- Must have junior or senior standing
- Must be enrolled as a full-time student with an accounting or business management major in an accredited college or university
- Must have a cumulative 2.5 grade point average or better
- Able to show financial need

### Frank W. Hill Memorial Scholarship

Established in memory of the late Frank W. Hill, past president of the BBNC Education Foundation from 1995-2007. He was a dedicated teacher and later served as superintendent of the Lake & Peninsula School District and co-director of the AFN Alaska Rural Systemic Initiative Program. He was a BBNC and Alaska Peninsula Corporation shareholder.

*ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:*

- Must be a BBNC shareholder
- Must have class standing of junior or senior or advanced degree candidate
- Must be enrolled as a full-time student in the education field in an accredited college or university
- Cumulative 2.5 grade point average or better
- Able to show financial need

## Wells Fargo – BBNC Scholarship up to \$5,000

Match scholarship established to further advance the education of Alaska Natives and to encourage interest in the banking profession, Wells Fargo and BBNC each contributes \$2,500 to the award. Award dependent upon funding.

### Eligibility Requirements:

- Must be a BBNC shareholder
- Must have class standing of junior or senior
- Must be enrolled as a full-time student in an accredited college or university with an interest in the banking profession
- Cumulative 2.0 grade point average or better
- Able to show financial need

## American Seafoods

The American Seafoods Company/Community Advisory Board Scholarship provides financial assistance for post-secondary education to promote the study of fisheries, biology and sciences. American Seafoods began its partnership with the BBNC Education Foundation in 2011 for the 2011-12 school year. Award dependent upon funding.

### Eligibility Requirements:

- Fund amounts vary depending on American Seafoods
- Must be a BBNC Shareholder
- Upper Class standing
- Enrolled with an accredited college as a full-time student with an interest in the fisheries, biology or science
- Cumulative 2.5 grade point average

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## BBNC Education Foundation HE/VE Scholarship Application Tips & Suggestions

1. Present a neat, (preferably typed) and complete scholarship application. Do not leave any portion of the application blank. Remember, your application represents you to the selection committee!
2. Submit your application and required attachments well in advance of the deadline date. To be fair to all applicants, only COMPLETE applications will be considered. It is your responsibility to make sure your application packet is complete. Call to confirm receipt of your application and all attachments.
3. Remember that your essay is very important; it is worth 30% of the grading criteria! This is your opportunity to personalize your application and convince the review committee to select you as a scholarship recipient. The committee will be looking for applicants who have strong career goals and the desire to succeed in their chosen field of study. Other topics you might want to highlight are:
  - *How you became interested in your chosen field of study.*
  - *Special circumstances that you want the selection committee to know (e.g. financial, academic performance, etc.).*
  - *Level of desire to work in the region or for the BBNC/Subsidiary Companies or other partners.*
4. Give the people that you ask to write your letters of recommendation the appropriate information about yourself, for example your field of study, background, grade point average, etc. Give them plenty of advance time to write the letters and ask for more than one copy (or make copies yourself) so that you can use them for more than one application, if necessary. Please note that your letters of recommendation must be current and dated within one year.
5. Order your official transcripts as soon as you can to avoid missing the application deadline date. Contact your financial aid office, advisor or other school official if you need help ordering your transcripts.

Official transcripts must be received by the application deadline date in order for an application to be considered complete by the deadline date. Official transcripts are required to verify enrollment, class standing and cumulative GPA. **Electronic versions are now accepted.** Certified **PDF transcripts must be delivered from a verified/secured source to [bbncef@bbnc.net](mailto:bbncef@bbnc.net)** via a secure transcript exchange company or as a certified PDF document.
